



CSC Ice Etiquette for StarSkaters

For harmonious, fun and safe sessions CSC Skaters will follow the following ice etiquette guidelines...

1. Always be aware of your surroundings while on the ice
2. Fast Track Skaters will stay with their group and coach at all times, unless instructed otherwise.
3. Skaters that are in the middle of a spin cannot see skaters approaching. Therefore all non-spinning skaters are expected to avoid skaters in a spin.
4. Skaters having their solo music played have right-of-way over ALL skaters, while in a lesson or not in a lesson. Everyone will attempt to stay out of the way of soloists, but solo skaters are responsible to avoid collisions with coaches and skaters.
5. Skaters in lessons have right of way over skaters not in lessons.
6. A friendly apology is expected if you get in someone's way or collide. Mutual respect and courtesy is a MUST!
7. Solo music may be played maximum 2x per Freeskate Session, unless a coach is working on choreography.
8. Skaters are to practice spins in the center of the ice. Corners are for jumping with exiting up the side boards, unless the skater is placing the jump where it sits in choreography.
9. Skaters are to keep moving and not monopolize one area of the ice.
10. Skaters are to work on the discipline of the session at the scheduled time when not in a lesson... Freeskate, Dance or Skills.
